- Implementing the It's Your Game and/or Reducing the Risk program (s) in the middle and/or high schools with strict observance of the programs' principles;
- Receiving technical assistance from UTPRC;
- Allowing an independent evaluator to conduct an evaluation of the program activities to assess student knowledge, attitudes, and behaviors.

Should any differences occur between the parties, these differences will be reviewed by a multi-site advisory group, comprising representatives from all participating sites until a mutually agreeable resolution is reached.





All eighth grade students will receive instruction pertaining to the prevention of pregnancy and sexually transmitted disease using an abstinence plus approach. The Alief ISD curriculum follows the state standard of teaching abstinence as the only 100% effective method of preventing pregnancy and sexually transmitted disease, but will also include abstinence plus instruction. This means the curriculum will also teach and show students ways to protect themselves if they do not choose abstinence. We are informing you of this because we realize this information may contain more details than you are comfortable with us sharing with your child.

Lessons will be taught from the "*It's Your Game....Keep it Real*" curriculum. This is a curriculum for middle school students developed to prevent HIV/AIDS, other sexually transmitted disease (STD) and pregnancy. Students attend classroom lessons and individualized computer-based sessions. Students will learn healthy life skills that are essential in decision making, setting personal limits and maintaining healthy relationships. Instruction includes an emphasis on refusal skills that enable students to avoid risky situations. The lessons emphasize that choosing not to have sex is the safest choice. In addition, the curriculum teaches students how to protect themselves from pregnancy and STDs using medically accurate information.
